Date: 22.07.2020 Mode: Online


Learning Objectives:


- a. Generate awareness about the causes and symptoms of Dengue-Malaria

Learning Objectives:


- Justify the need for social work during Pandemic phase

Learning Objectives:


- a. Analyze the effect of COVID-19 Lockdown on climate change protection activities

Mode: Online


Learning Objectives
