Loreto College, Kolkata Report 2023 – 2024

Loreto College has had a successful year with seminars, workshops, talks & programmes contributing to the growth and development of the college.

NSS & Social Service Activities

Our students have taken part in many outreach activities, which core an integral part of college life. The Social Service Society of Loreto College, Kolkata organizes a **Blood Donation Campaign** in collaboration with the Association of Voluntary Blood Donors, West Bengal twice a year

The NSS Society of the College held and conducted many programmes – it organised a series of programmes under the Meri Maati Mera Desh initiative to celebrate *Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav*. It observed *NSS Day* by arranging for a Shramdaan Activity (physical efforts towards community welfare). A group of 10 volunteers visited St. Joseph's Old Age Home located at AJC Bose Road, Kolkata to offer their services to the elderly. The society organized a series of clean-up drives in collaboration with Bhoomi Foundation to celebrate *World Cleanup Day*. It took the initiative of spreading awareness and joy during the festive season. A group of 11 NSS volunteers *visited Bal Shiksha Sadan*, a Government Primary School to spread awareness regarding the significance of Yoga in our daily lives. The students participated in the *Khadi Mahotsav Rally* organized by the National Service Scheme Unit of Calcutta University. A *Special Camp* was held in Ladies Park on Ramesh Mitra Road at Bhawanipore. The students visited *Jwalaberia Adibasi F. P. School* located in South 24 Parganas. This outreach programme was conducted in collaboration with Samobeto, a non-profit organisation working for marginalised groups in the education and health sectors. The students also visited *Bal Shiksha Sadan School* on the occasion of *World Happiness Day*.

Talks/Workshops related to Environment, Commemorative Days, Events and Festivals

A talk was organized on *World AIDS Day* to spread awareness about HIV/AIDS and dispel common myths associated with the disease. *International Human Rights Day* was celebrated with a Special Lecture on Child Rights and the Gaza War. *Earth Day Week Celebration* was organized by the W.E Nature Society. The West Bengal Pollution Control Board (WBPCB) organized a Quiz programme for the *Celebration of World Environment Day and WBPCB's Golden Jubilee Celebration* at Biswa Bangla Convention Centre. This was attended by 13 UG students and a faculty member. *International Women's Day* was celebrated in the college through a programme organized by the Women's Study Society and Eastern Cultural Society. *International Yoga Day* was celebrated by the B.Ed. Department in association with IQAC.

Students' Meet

Kalakriti, an annual event was organised by the Department of Psychology and the Psychology Society of Loreto College, Kolkata. This year marked the 13th successful celebration of Kalakriti, bringing together individuals from six participating schools to showcase their diverse abilities. The Department of History, in collaboration with the History Society of Loreto College, Kolkata, organised its annual inter-college students' meet *Historia* on May 16, 2024. The theme for this year's Historia was *Popular Rebellions*. The 10th edition of the annual academic fest of the Department of Economics, Loreto College, Kolkata, *Ecolore 2024*, was organized, where young minds from various esteemed colleges of Kolkata showcased their reflections on the theme *Economic Growth and Distributive Justice: Perspectives for a Changing World*. The Department of Political Science, Loreto College, Kolkata convened the annual students', known as *'Dialego'*. This year's theme was *Emerging India in a Multipolar World Order*.

Field trips
