Agenda 6: AOB

Sr. Christine Coutinho informed the members that the proposal for starting the Masters programme in Psychology has been approved. Prof. Biswas reiterated that the West Bengal Council for Higher Education will be coming for inspection. After they issue a no-objection certificate there will be an inspection by Calcutta University.

The proposal for starting Honours in Sociology has also been approved, conditional to it being a self-financing subject. This was not regarded as feasible and therefore the College would not be starting Honours in Sociology at this point of time.

The Anti-ragging Committee will be conducting an informative session and has been asked to be vigilant and report any cases of ragging that might take place.

Ms. Debolina Mukherjee has been appointed as a librarian.

The Orientation for the parents of First Year students will be conducted.

One staff member had to opt for voluntary retirement because of ill health. That has been approved by Bikash Bhavan.

Prof Debasish Biswas clarified certain points regarding the CCF pertaining to internship.

3 credits have been allotted for internship. The guidelines have not been finalized. Due to the constraints of providing internship to all students of the University, two alternatives have been suggested Community engagement programme and Field Project. The internship will be for 7 to 15 days and will comprise 75 marks. After completion there will be an evaluation, the modalities of which have not been finalized. The University aims to release the guidelines before the Pujas. Dr. Kaustuva Banerjee asked whether the students will be given 2 weeks off for internship. Internships will take place during the summer was the response.

Prof. Biswas also informed the members that there were some suggestions regarding the CVAC. He stated that proposals for new courses could be given to the University in 15 days. The Syndicate would approve of the proposals, if found suitable.

Concern was expressed about the syllabus of the Human Rights CVAC syllabus not being published. Prof Biswas suggested that the College could frame a syllabus and send it to the Secretary of the Undergraduate Council.

Prof Biswas informed the members that the examination regulations have almost been finalized and published in a fortnight.

Prof. Biswas said that for the NEP to be properly implemented, autonomy is imperative.

Dr. Ranjita Dawn pointed out the challenges of conducting examinations under the new system.

Concern was voiced about students scoring high marks under the CBCS system. If this continues under the new system it will be difficult to accommodate so many students in the fourth year as most of them can easily score above the cut off marks.

The IQAC Coordinator stated that a Research Methodology Course would be conducted for the advanced learners of Sixth Semester English Honours students as well as those pursuing their Masters in English. The students of the English Department could not be included in the previous course as it was for the students of the Social Science Departments which did not include English.

Dr. Dawn raised the issue of Leave rules as it is imperative that teachers who are due for promotion under the Career Advancement Scheme are aware of the Leave Rules. This is necessary as the promotion documents require the number and kind of leave taken by the concerned teacher. Ms. Chakravarty also pointed out that it was important for teachers who are close to retirement to get their service books in order for their pension to be sanctioned. Leaves are an integral part in the preparation of the service books. Prof. Debasish Biswas the Inspector of Colleges had assured Dr. Mitra that he would send Sister Christine Coutinho a copy of the Leave Rules. Dr. Guha requested Dr. Mitra to follow up with Dr. Biswas.

Dr. Sayantani Chatterjee pointed out that Calcutta University has not yet conducted the Inspection for Masters in Psychology. That is the last round to be conducted. Bikash Bhavan has conducted the Inspection. Dr. Guha requested Dr. Chatterjee to talk to the Head of the Psychology Department Dr. Dinaz Jeejeebhoy and to follow up with the University.

Mrs. Sharmila Mitra Deb proposed that an Honours in Sociology could be started by the College. This has several challenges as the Government is not sanctioning any new posts. Some solutions were put forward like increasing the fees or finding out whether State Aided Contractual Teachers could be recruited.

Several members proposed that college timings should be reduced with a single break as in all other colleges and college could take place in two shifts with the introduction of new courses.

Dr. Bonny Ghosh pointed out the College is growing but the number of library staff has been reduced. She said that the college needs more library personnel. There is no non-teaching staff dedicated to the library. Dr. Devika Guha and Dr. Kaustuva Banerjee agreed with Dr. Ghosh and said that the B.Ed. library is opened for much shorter hours than earlier due to the lack of a librarian. Dr. Ghosh was assured that the matter would be looked into.

Mrs. Kavneet Khullar, Principal Trustee of Akshar suggested that Loreto College can collaborate with Akshar for Training on Inclusive Education for B.Ed students. Duration of training can be decided by both the institutions. Dr. Kaustava Banerjee confirmed that she would take up the matter.

Prof. Debasish Biswas suggested that an Add-on Course on survey, sampling, analysis could be designed because many colleges who have started internship this year have been suggested by NGOs/Institutes that if students come with the basic knowledge, it would benefit them during internships. Dr. Sanghita Sanyal (in charge of the Certificate Courses) suggested that it can be taken forward as a Certificate Course.

Prof. Debasish Biswas also stated that University of Calcutta has suggested that skill-based courses could be introduced as part of Major courses. He stated that value-added course on life skills would be very helpful for the students. He suggested that we can introduce one skill-based subject as a Minor subject. Prof. Biswas stated that students could be given opportunities for internship beyond the list prepared by Board of Studies of respective departments and published by University of Calcutta.

So skill-based courses should be introduced like tailoring, aviation.
