

Learning Outcomes

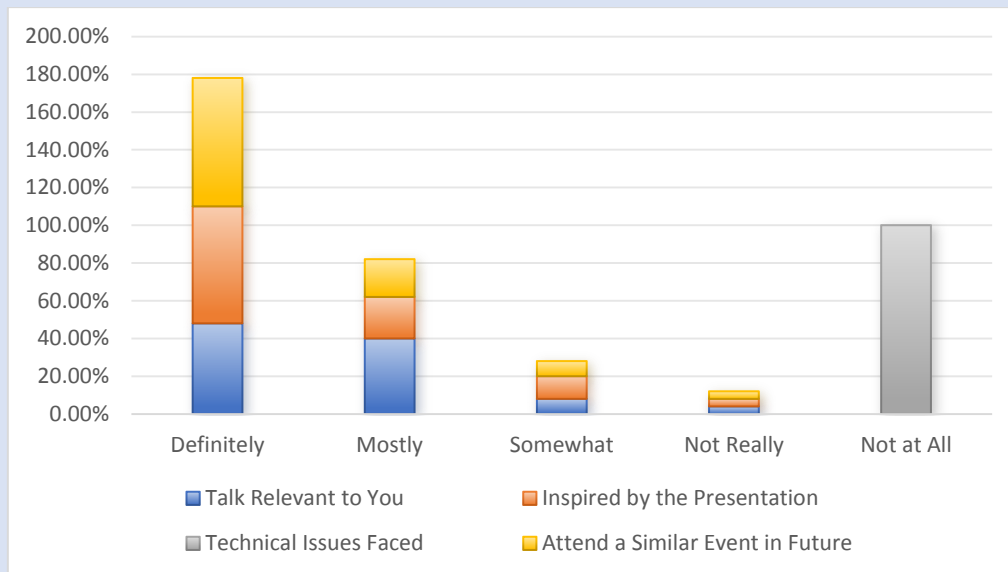
At the end of the session, the students were able to:

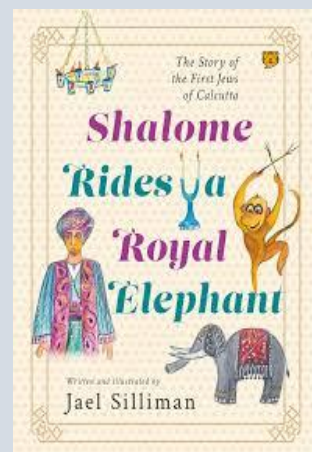
