- 3. Answer any one of the following :
  - (a) Discuss how Browning's 'The Bishop Orders His Tomb at Saint Praxed's Church' exhibits the deceit and pretence of the Victorian spiritual climate.
  - (b) Discuss Matthew Arnold's views on the two major socio-cultural forces of England of his time with reference to *Culture and Anarchy*.

4. Answer any one of the following :

- (a) In Browning's poem 'Andrea Del Sarto' does Andrea excuse his past life?
- (b) Explain and comment : "And how entirely does the narrow and mechanical conception of our secular business proceed from a narrow and mechanical conception of our religious business!"
